#### **Admission Criteria**

- 1. Academic Qualifications for Application
  - ① Applicants who hold a Bachelor's degree from an accredited undergraduate institution
  - ② Applicants can apply for a major different from that of their previous degree
- ③ Applicants who are expected graduates must be able to submit their graduation certificate before February 28, 2026
  However, expected graduates that have completed their coursework at institutions in Japan may submit the certificate by April 30, 2026.
- 2. Applicant Eligibility for International Students
  - ① Foreign nationals whose parents both have foreign citizenship (non-Korean students whose parents are both non-Korean)
  - ② Foreign (non-Korean) applicants who have completed all their educational courses and degrees (equivalent to primary, secondary, and university education) in a foreign country for more than 16 years

#### **Required Documents**

①Application Form (Completed and printed online application form) ②Study Plan (The study plan should be written using the designated form) ③ Certificate of Graduation (Bachelor's Degree) or (Apostilled Diploma) [Original] ④ Official Transcript (Bachelor's Degree)—The percentage of the average score for all grades must be stated ⑤ Degree Certificate from the China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center [Original] (Only for Chinese university graduates) ⑥ Degree Verification Form (Only for overseas university graduates) ⑦ Korean or English Proficiency Test Reports [Original] (Holders Only) / Certificate of Career or Employment (Holders Only) ⑧ For foreign applicants, please submit the following additional documents:

▶ Student–parent relationship certificate issued by the government ▶ Copy of National Identification card: Applicant's and both parents' ▶ Copy of Applicant's Passport and Copy of Applicant's Alien Registration Card (Holders only) ▶ Diploma and Transcripts from Elementary, Middle, and High School (Submitted only by applicants who have completed their entire elementary, middle, and high school curriculum (16 years or more) abroad)
