## Dean's Greeting

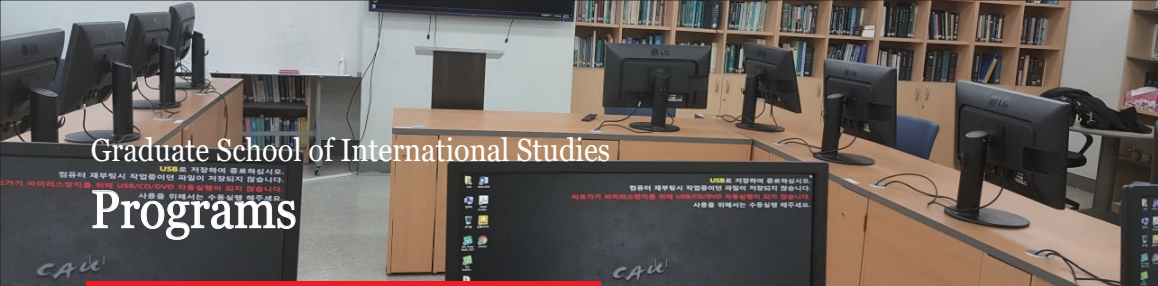

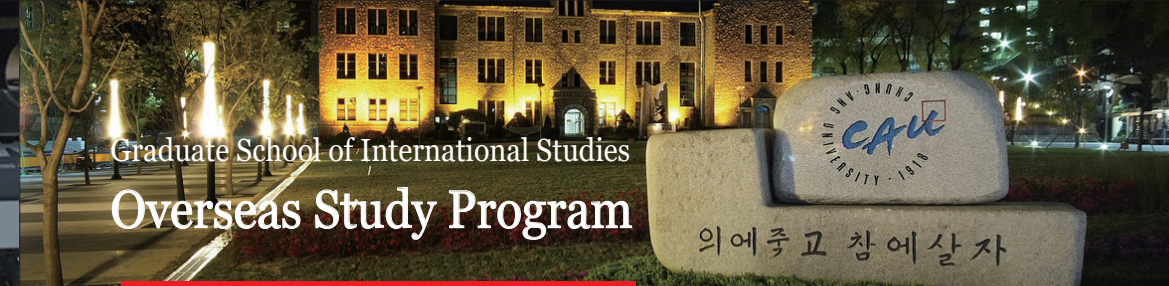

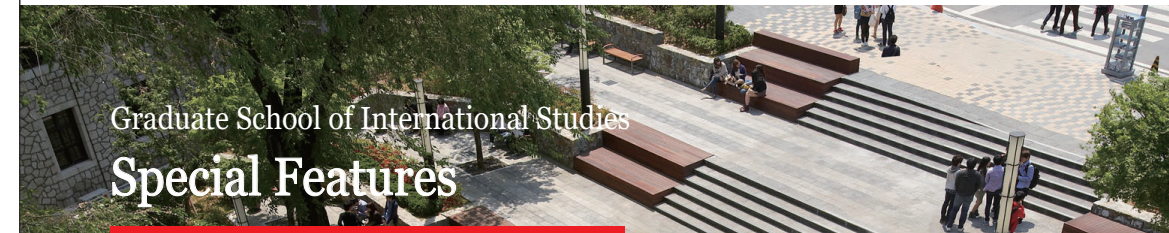
